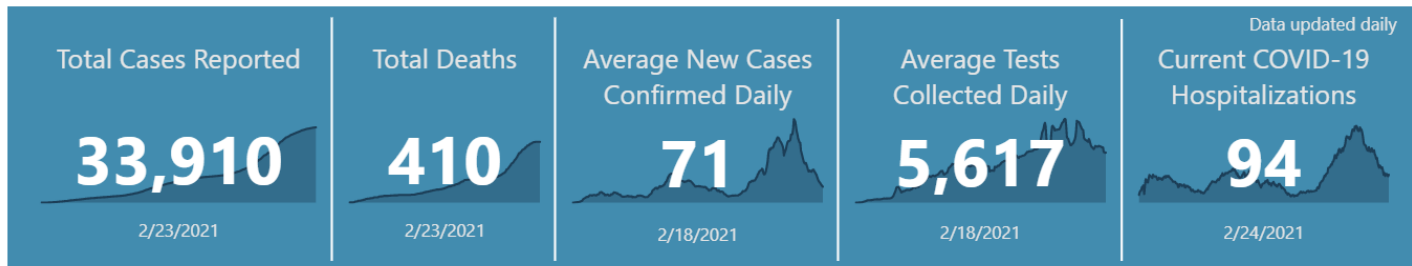




## Update on COVID-19 & the City's Response, February 26

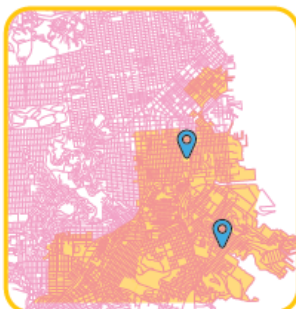
**Vacunas COVID-19 para personas mayores de 65 años que viven en los códigos postales 94110, 94112, 94107, 94124 y 94134**

- 1) Vivir en los códigos postales 94110, 94112, 94107, 94124 o 94134;
- 2) Tener 65 años o más

No es necesario pedir cita. No se requiere seguro médico.
